"These things I have spoken to you so that you may be kept from stumbling. They will make you outcasts from the synagogue, but an hour is coming for everyone who kills you to think that he is offering service to God. These things they will do because they have not known the Father or Me." John 16:1-3.

From Abel to Isaiah, to Jeremiah, to Zechariah, to John the Baptist, to Stephen and James, then Peter, Paul, Polycarp, Tyndale, and countless others over the centuries in every corner of the planet and now to Charlie. If you are reviled for the name of Christ, you are blessed, because the Spirit of glory and of God rests on you" 1 Pet. 4:12-14.

Let us commit to two things: "preach the word; be ready in season and out of season;" 1 Tim. 4:2. and "that you love one another, even as I have loved you, that you also love one another. By this all men will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another." John 13:34-35. If the arrows pierce my soul, let them come from without and not within.


