Will the real me step forward

Imagine arriving at church one morning but the entrance is blocked by a prophet, a real prophet sent from God. Before you walk in and "praise God" you have to deal with who you have been all week, what you have said and what you have done. If my week has been all about me, my feelings, my wants, and my own pride, then I won't be let in to worship.

That is what Jeremiah was demanding of the people in Jeremiah 7. They came to the temple and felt protection because of the temple. They came to praise and worship, not realizing that true worship is who we are 7 days a week, 24 hours a day.

"Will you steal, murder, and commit adultery and swear falsely, and offer sacrifices to Baal and walk after other gods that you have not known, ¹⁰then come and stand before Me in this house, which is called by My name, and say, 'We are delivered!'—that you may do all these abominations?" _{Jer. 7:9-10}.

In other words, will you live by God's virtues, or do you think you can be selfish, egotistical, prideful, arrogant, hurtful and still stand before God in confidence as you sing songs, take the Lord's Supper and say a few prayers?

Imagine that you could not gather with the church and praise God unless first your life that week was revealed for all to see! Many would not even want to approach that church gathering. Imagine if your posts, your texts were for the world to see? But the unfortunate reality is sometimes we don't even feel the guilt or shame as we attack and devour one another. Jer. 8:12 speaks of such "religious people" "They did not know how to blush."

Imagine of a church group chat was published for the entire country to see. Would those seeking to find God even think of approaching our group? Or would they see the same hostile attitudes they can find in the world without adding to it in a church?

"Therefore I, the prisoner of the Lord, implore you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling with which you have been called, with all humility and gentleness, with patience, showing tolerance for one another in love, being diligent to preserve the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace." Eph. 4:1-3.

This is Christian worship. True worship is not those songs you sing or taking of the Lord's Supper. What we call worship is what God calls a reminder of why we worship daily, and in every conversation, action or deed.

Here is the "Christian" definition of worship: "present your bodies a living and holy sacrifice, acceptable to God, which is your spiritual service of worship. ²And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, so that you may prove what the will of God is, that which is good and acceptable and perfect." Rom. 12:1-2.

I think far too many people in church think their self-righteousness justifies their heartless words and actions. Far too many people in church have their own way of practicing their form of righteousness. For them, They have their own version of Ephesians 4:1-3. It goes something like this: "Therefore... walk in a manner of pride... with arrogance, harsh words, snap judgments, not caring about the pain inflicted by your words as long as you think you are right. And be diligent to eviscerate anyone you disagree with."

Yes, we can be right in our understanding but completely damned by our attitude. Worship is our love for God and our love for one another. Jesus himself said that is the foundation of life with God.
